

- I. Fold the paper width wise across the middle line.
- 2. Bring corner A to Circle A. DO NOT FOLD OR CREASE!
- 3. Bring corner B to Circle B. DO NOT FOLD OR CREASE!
- 4. Use a piece of tape or a staple to hold the two corners in place.
- 5. Make a hole through the circle behind corners A and B, and tie your string to this hole. Add tape for extra strength.




Playful Learning at Home!

Easy Flight Kite

Here is how to make an east and awesome kite out of only paper, tape, and string!

- 1. Fold the paper width wise in the middle with the crease facing up.
- 2. Bring the lower right corner up to the top crease, about two inches from the right. (DO NOT CREASE OR FOLD!)
- 3. Do the same with the other corner on the back side of the paper.
- 4. Use a piece of tape or a staple to hold the two corners in place.



All finished! You can use tape around any of the holes for added strength. Add ribbons onto the back of the kite, or decorate the paper with fun designs!
